### Epiphany Assisted Living

Epiphany Assisted Living opened in January 2000, with 50 assisted living apartments and 14 memory care apartments.

Residents here are given a wide variety of amenities, including meals, housekeeping and a whole host of outings and activities.

Epiphany Assisted Living's own home health care agency assists residents with a wide variety of services, including bathing, grooming and dressing, medication adminis-

In the summer of 1964, Father Reiser told the new Epiphany Parish leadership group that the vision for Epiphany needed to include Senior Housing, so that seniors would be able to have a significant role in parish life over the unfolding years of the parish.

That dream has been fulfilled.

Residents living in Epiphany Senior Housing (that is Epiphany Assisted Living and Epiphany Pines), live in a peacefully tranquil environment and are cared for with efficient gentility and expert professionalism.

A wildlife preserve area surrounding Epiphany Senior Housing promotes a sense of tranquility and peace to residents as they socialize or spend time on the outside patios watching deer, ducks and fox graze the grounds.

tration, and laundry.

Services are planned with each resident to reflect personal needs and to offer choices while respecting privacy and supporting independence.

Assistance is offered to those who need it, but don't require 24-hour skilled nursing.

The Epiphany Assisted Living memory care unit allows those with Alzheimer's disease or dementia to receive the care they need, but still allows them to live independently in their own private apartment.

"Our goal is to keep folks as independent as possible for as long as possible," said Laurie Anderson, resident director.

### Epiphany Pines

Epiphany Pines, a 107-unit independent living complex for seniors 55 and older, opened its doors in the fall of 1994 and has been serving the senior population in a premiere fashion ever since.

Each apartment is equipped with a full kitchen, laundry hook-ups, emergency call system and indi-

vidually controlled heat/air conditioning.

Our beautiful building boasts of its well-stocked grocery store, library, cinema room, craft/billiards room, beauty shop and gift shop.

Epiphany Pines provides van service for weekly shopping and other outings, and a full calendar of events provide opportunity for a variety of socialization. Wellness clinic visits are scheduled weekly.

"You will find that the people at Epiphany Pines are friendly and gracious," said Mary McCarty, manager at Epiphany Pines.
